Pietro Ameglio is one of the most important teachers and practitioners of active nonviolence in Latin America today. He cofounded the Mexican Movement for Peace with Justice and Dignity (MPJD) in 2011 in response to the spiraling toll of killed and disappeared persons in the so-called “war on drugs.”

He is author of “Gandhi and Civil Disobedience: Mexico Today” (2002), served as Chair of the Humanities Department at La Salle University in Cuernavaca, and holds Special Chairs in Peace Culture and Nonviolent Civil Resistance in the School of Philosophy and Literature at the National Autonomous University in Mexico City. He received the *El Hibri* Peace Education Prize in 2014.
